SCHEDULE A**CONDITIONS OF PERMIT TO MOVE**

It is an express condition of this permit that the permit holder assumes full responsibility for making him/herself acquainted with the following conditions, along with the physical limitations that may prevail along the route that is to be used.

1. The permit holder shall move the vehicle or loaded vehicle described herein entirely at his/her own risk.
2. Loader buckets that extend beyond the width of the trailer must be tipped in an upward or downward position so that the cutting edges are not exposed.
3. The load shall be moved by means of equipment of a type approved by the City of Edmonton, Director of Network Operations, Parks and Roads Services, and by such equipment only.
4. Under no circumstances shall the permit holder remove any signs or structures along the highways or bridges without first obtaining permission from the Director of Network Operations, Parks and Roads Services.
5. Where the vehicle or loaded vehicle to be moved is over height, the permit holder shall determine if there are any telephone, telegraph, Edmonton LRT wires, power wires, traffic lights, street light power cables, and any bridges and other over head structures under which the vehicle or loaded vehicle will have to be moved. Under no circumstances may the vehicle or loaded vehicle be moved until consent from the City of Edmonton has been granted.
6. If the vehicle or loaded vehicle is being moved, is of such dimensions as to obstruct or make it difficult for ordinary traffic to pass the same, the permit holder shall arrange to have an escort vehicle posted some distance in front of and behind the vehicle or loaded vehicle in order to warn the traveling public. Every possible effort shall be made to assist the traveling public and to avoid delays.
7. If so directed, the permit holder shall arrange for supervision by the City of Edmonton, Director of Network Operations, Parks and Roads Services, and will be subjected to his/her instructions. The permit holder shall be responsible to the City of Edmonton for all costs of supervision and shall pay such costs upon receipt of an invoice from the City of Edmonton.
8. In case of breakdown of equipment, mechanical difficulties, or other adverse conditions, the permit holder shall not abandon the vehicle or loaded vehicle on any highway but shall make arrangements immediately to remove the vehicle or loaded vehicle from such highway.

9. If during the movement of a vehicle or loaded vehicle covered under this permit, a hazard has been created to the public by any cause, including but not limited to, a vehicle or loaded vehicle becoming stationary on the highway or damage done to a bridge or culvert or other structure along the highway, the permit holder shall notify the City of Edmonton, Director of Network Operations, Parks and Roads Services immediately and shall provide all possible assistance to the public using the highway in order to prevent injury to persons or property.
10. The permit holder shall assume all responsibility for injury to persons or damage to roads, bridges, and other public private property caused directly or indirectly by the transportation of a vehicle or loaded vehicle under this permit, and he/she shall hold harmless The City of Edmonton, its officers, agents, employees and servants from all suits, claims, damages or proceedings of any kind arising directly or indirectly from the transportation of a vehicle or loaded vehicle under this permit. Such security and/or indemnity as required by the City of Edmonton shall be provided by the permit holder.
11. Any deviation from the conditions of this permit by the permit holder shall be sufficient cause to revoke or cancel this permit and to withhold further issuance of permits to the permit holder.
12. If this permit is issued over the telephone, the permit holder accepts that the information supplied by him/her has been accurately recorded by a City representative. The absence of a signature from the applicant does not render this permit.
13. This permit is not valid over banned highways where axle weights exceed ban levels, or posted bridge levels.
14. This permit is not valid if the dimensions of vehicle or loaded vehicle exceed ban levels, or posted bridge levels.
15. Any person who violates the provisions contained in this permit is guilty of an offence under Section 88 & 89 of City of Edmonton Traffic Bylaw #5590.
16. This permit is null and void if the conditions of axle loads are not met.
17. Over dimension and overweight movements are subject to the provisions contained in the Province of Alberta Motor Transport Act, Vehicle Over Dimensional and Overweight Regulations.

Upon granting of this permit by the City of Edmonton, Parks and Roads Services, City Operations, the attached application becomes and forms part of this permit.
